



Fred J Rosenbaum Memorial Display

The commemoration of Bryan 316 and Bryan 306 laboratories to the memory of Fred J. Rosenbaum was marked by the commission of sculpture in the form of a brass plaque. The above case work was designed and constructed by Paul Discher in order to display this plaque and is located on the south wall of Bryan Hall outside Bryan room 316.

The brass plaque was framed and centered on a finished 1/2 inch oak plywood base trimmed in fluted oak casing and rosettes. Raised cutout polished brass lettering trims the top portion of the display and flanking plexiglass display cases are used to exhibit student laboratory news and photographs.
